RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE our topic is about **PEOPLE OF OTHER FAITHS.** We will learn about what the Church teaches about other faiths. In "Other Faiths Week," we will also learn about **Sikhism.**

we can take action to protect our planet.


GEOGRAPHY

This term, we will be exploring the Geography of the United Kingdom. We will learn about our country's human features and physical features. We will learn how to use the language of urban and rural and we will find out about how villages, towns and cities have developed.



WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term we will be inspired in our writing by our reading of, High Rise Mystery' (a detective novel), by Sharna Jackson. Our main focus will be an extended narrative in the detective genre. We will also cover:-

ART AND DESIGN

In Art this term, we will develop our painting skills and create a landscape of an African country of our choice.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

We will explore structures to create a papier mache masks, inspired by our learning last term about the Benin Kingdom.

MATHS

This term, the class will be consolidating a variety of mathematical concepts, including:

- Mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- Rounding decimal numbers to two decimal places.
- Understanding percentages and record as fractions and decimals.
- Mental multiplication and division and problem solving involving decimals and money.
- Calculate perimeter and areas of composite shapes using formula in words and standard unit for square.
- Reading and using bus tables, graphs and charts
